8th Grade Math requires the use of calculators. The Texas Instruments **Ti-30XS MultiView** will be provided in the classroom and for testing. It would be very beneficial for each student to have one at home. If you purchase a calculator make sure to get the exact model, **Ti-30XS MultiView** it is available locally for about \$16 or Amazon for \$15.

CLASS ORGANIZATION

Binder: Each student will receive hole-punched pages that have to be placed in the ring binder and will serve as the class workbook. Each student will also receive a bound and hole-punched daily warm-up book to place in the ring binder as well. **You must bring this binder to class every day.**

Textbook

I have already incorporated parts of the new text into my printed materials and will continue to expand upon it as the year progresses. All students will be issued a new consumable math text called GO MATH.
